SPECTACULAR SURROUNDINGS

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EALING TOWN HALL

BUILT IN 1887 TO CELEBRATE THE GROWTH OF LOCAL DEMOCRACY IN THE BOROUGH, THE SPECTACULAR GRADE II LISTED VICTORIAN BUILDING WAS EXPANDED IN 1930 TO CREATE THE TOWN HALL BUILDING OF TODAY. 120 YEARS LATER, IT IS STILL PROVIDING THE SAME PUBLIC FUNCTION THAT IT WAS BUILT FOR.

VICTORIA HALL

Designed by Ealing's Victorian Engineer and Surveyor, Charles Jones, to commemorate Queen Victoria's Golden Jubilee, this grand Gothic Revival style hall with its hammerbeam roof effect is approached via an impressive ceremonial staircase. This room is the largest in the Town Hall and can accommodate 450 guests theatre style or 250 guests seated at round tables. With a sprung wooden floor and atmospheric lighting, it is a fantastic venue for dancing with a large stage available for a band or disco.

The Victoria Hall can be used in conjunction with the Princes Hall for a range of events. Whether hosting a conference in the Victoria Hall and using the Princes Hall as a lunch venue or using the Princes Hall for pre-dinner drinks before 'wowing' your guests as they walk into the Victoria Hall, the options available at Ealing Town Hall make it the perfect location to hold your event. The two rooms also work well for segregated events.



PRINCES HALL

A contemporary space designed with three split levels allowing for pre-dinner drinks, dining and after-dinner dancing in different areas. Easily transformed with soft lighting, this venue offers an intimate atmosphere for up to 200 guests.

NELSON ROOM

The original council chamber prior to the addition of the East Wing in 1930, this elegantly decorated room reveals attractive William Morris style wallpaper and a mahogany fireplace. This space is ideal for dinner parties for up to 60 guests or a drinks reception for up to 100 guests.



TELFER ROOM

Renovated in 2011, the Telfer Room offers 80m² of versatile event space suitable for yoga, dance, pilates and exercise classes. With a Harlequin sprung floor, mirrored wall, portable ballet barre, inbuilt sound system, air conditioning and changing room facilities, this space is perfect for your next exercise class.



ELIZABETH CANTELL ROOM

Named after a well-known local personality from the 1980's, this modern, fully accessible room is ideal for meetings, small exhibitions and fairs, Henna parties, small buffet suppers and young children's parties.

COUNCIL CHAMBER

While not a conventional event space, the Council Chamber offers clients a truly unique event experience. Sitting in the home of democracy in Ealing since the 1930's, the Council Chamber offers clients a truly unique event experience. 70 delegates can be accommodated in the elegant fixed wooden seating and as each seat has an individual microphone, there can be no excuses for lack of participation!



COMMITTEE ROOMS

There are two committee rooms suitable for meetings from 10-20 guests, ideal for business meetings, training sessions and committee group discussions.

GREENFORD HALL

GREENFORD HALL WAS BUILT AFTER A 12 YEAR CAMPAIGN BY THE PEOPLE OF GREENFORD TO OBTAIN A PUBLIC HALL FOR THE TOWN. IT WAS OFFICIALLY OPENED ON 16 APRIL 1966 BY ONE OF THE COUNTRY'S FOREMOST STAGE AND FILM ACTORS, DAME EDITH EVANS.

THE SCANDINAVIAN INFLUENCED FAÇADE AND INTERIOR WAS EXTENSIVELY REFURBISHED IN 2011. THE VENUE CAN ACCOMMODATE 10-500 GUESTS AND IS SUITABLE FOR ALL TYPES OF EVENTS RANGING FROM WEDDING RECEPTIONS TO LARGE COMMUNITY MEETINGS.

ASSEMBLY HALL

Combined with the adjoining anteroom, the large hall, with it's stunning lighting, is a perfect venue for large dinner dance events or presentations and exhibitions. 400 guests can be seated at round tables. If utilising the balcony, large conference and award ceremonies can accommodate up to 500 guests. Updated stage sound and lighting offers the latest facilities for a wide range of productions from one-night shows to pantomimes and comedy nights.



CYRIL GRANT ROOM

A bright and well lit self-contained space located on the first floor, the Cyril Grant Room also offers a separate kitchen, toilets and bar area. This room is ideal for regular meetings and classes as well as mid-sized social functions as it can accommodate 100 guests for dining or theatre style seated events for 140.
